

Presentations and working with the material

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd uses Montessori teaching principles to present the most essential realities of the Catholic faith to even very young children. The catechist uses specially designed materials and inspiring presentations to help children explore areas of the faith appropriate to their developmental age. The outcome is a profoundly personal and joyful expression of faith, unique to each child's relationship with God.



The catechist gives a presentation to the children, either in a group or individually. After the presentation the children are invited to work with the material.



Through the further work with the materials children are able to further reflect and internalize the lessons in a profound way. The result is often one of contemplation, deep inner peace and joy.
