With all its uncertainties, 2020-2021 was a fruitful year for St. John the Evangelist! With Mass restrictions and the quarantines in place, we estimated a 25% decrease in collections; however, our generous parishioners exceeded that estimate by \$3,000. In addition, St John the Evangelist received a few major gifts, which combined with collections, led to an above average total income. With limited activities and ministries during the pandemic, we were able to significantly reduce expenses. This led to an overall surplus of nearly \$30,000.

Let us give thanks to God for His great generosity to all of us in this cluster and school. Through a difficult time, He has filled us with the Holy Spirit and encourages us to persevere. We are moving forward with many plans. As a cluster we have just celebrated Picnic & Praise. What a great event to bring us all back together. Faith Formation programs will be starting soon; registration is available online now. September 1st, St Joseph Catholic School will begin with all the first day of school excitement. Advent Adoration, December 8, will be an evening of prayer and reflection featuring national speaker Mary Bielski. Another exciting aspect of this coming year is that each church has plans for renovating and upgrading various features. These plans will be announced at the proper time. 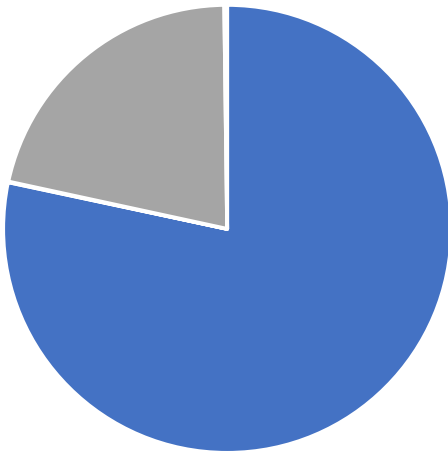

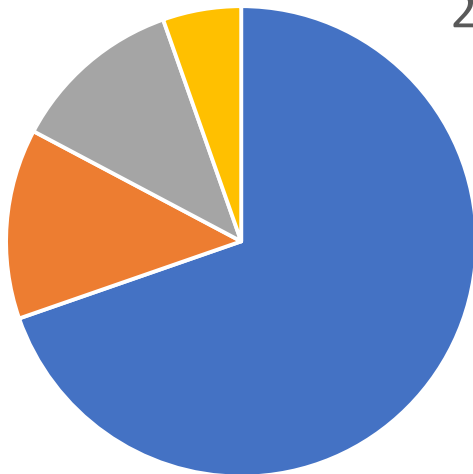
St John the Evangelist Income 2020-2021
