With all its uncertainties, 2020-2021 was a fruitful year for St. Joseph Church and School! With the Mass restrictions, we estimated a significant decrease in collections, but our parishioners were very generous, and collections stayed relatively constant over the course of the year. On top of that, our church and school received \$250,000 from Foster Friess, on behalf of his Rice Lake High School classmates. Combined with that was the generous donation of a 1967 Mustang, which raised another \$100,000 through a raffle. These generous gifts totaling \$350,000, along with the steady support from collections and tuition, allowed St. Joseph Church and School to end the year with an income surplus of nearly \$200,000.

Let us give thanks to God for His great generosity to all of us in this cluster and school. Through a difficult time, He has filled us with the Holy Spirit and encourages us to persevere. We are moving forward with many plans. As a cluster we have just celebrated Picnic & Praise. What a great event to bring us all back together. Faith Formation programs will be starting soon; registration is available online now. September 1st, St Joseph Catholic School will begin with all the first day of school excitement. Advent Adoration, December 8, will be an evening of prayer and reflection featuring national speaker Mary Bielski. Another exciting aspect of this coming year is that each church has plans for renovating and upgrading various features. These plans will be announced at the proper time. Overall, it is a good time to be Catholic and a good time to belong to this cluster. Thank you for your involvement and commitment.

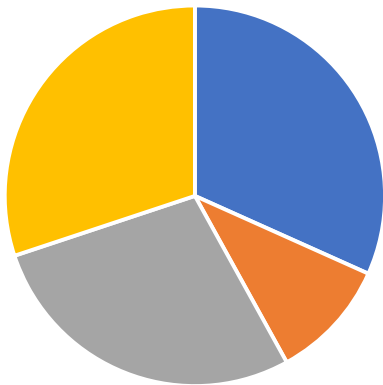

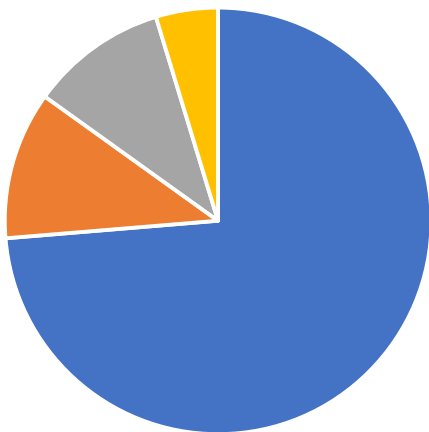
St Joseph Income 2020-2021
